STAFF REPORT

**Agenda Item 6: Petition for Change to the State Water Board
on District License 13898
Monday, July 7, 2025**

The Strategic Plan relevant priority is **Use** by maximizing beneficial use of water under the District's water right license.

- Eliminating restrictions on the District's license will allow for more water users to benefit from the District's access to stored water in Lake Mendocino when other water rights and sources are unavailable.
- Changes to the license will also assist in compliance with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) by allowing the broadest use of water under the license.

General Background on Change Petitions

A petition is needed to make changes to a water right permit, license, or a pending application.

Q: What happens when a petition for change is filed?

A: Before approving any change petition, the State Water Board must find that the change will not injure any legal water user (including any water right holders who are junior in priority and anyone who contracts with a legal water user) and that the change will not have unreasonable effects on fish or wildlife.

If a petitioned change has the potential to impact other water users or the environment, the State Water Board will inform those who have requested notification about the petition. The petitioner is usually required to notify the Department of Fish and Wildlife of the proposed change. Other water right holders and the public may object to the proposed change by filing a protest form with the State Water Board. Because the State Water Board has discretion over whether or not to approve the requested petition, it must comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) before approving the change or extension petition.

The petitioner generally will be required to hire a consultant to prepare any environmental document required by CEQA, to pay for the cost of preparing the document, and to provide enough information to allow the State Water Board to make the required findings. Before it can approve the petition, all protests must be resolved, either through negotiation or by the State Water Board following an investigation or hearing, depending on how much water is involved.

Q: How long will it take to get a petition for change approved?

A: It depends on the change being requested. If the change is minor, it could take three months. If the change is major or controversial, it will take longer. The most controversial changes can take as long as 10 years to process, but most don't take that long.

Water Right Terms

The following are the typical terms in a water right. Review the types of petitions and which process best meets your need. Changes will be evaluated based on how they affect other right holders and the environment.

The following can be changed:

- Place and purpose of use
- Due diligence deadlines
- Point of diversion
- Public trust terms
- CEQA mitigation measures
- Other conditions

The following can **not** be changed:

- Source
- Quantity of diversion or use
- Season of diversion
- Priority date

Risks Associated with Filing a Water Right License Change Petition

Questions:

What are the risks of filing a change petition? What additional terms could the State Water Board impose on the License? For example, could the quantity of water be reduced from 7,940 afy?

Answers from District Legal Counsel:

There are always risks when filing a petition for change. Filing a petition opens it up to a protest from anyone, state agencies included. The quantity of the licensed water could not be reduced, however.

In order to approve a change petition, the State Water Board must find the change will not injure any legal water user and that the change will not harm fish or wildlife. As such, CA Department of Fish and Wildlife, or some other protestant, could file a protest requesting additional conditions on the license, which the State Water Board would then consider.

The District's recourse is to withdraw a petition for change however, since the District's right was licensed so recently, it is not likely there would be much scrutiny in the way of imposing conditions.

Petition for Change Process

Step One – Submittal and Consult

- Provide copy of full petition to Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) and California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) and request consult with both regarding the potential effects of the proposed change(s) on water quality, fish, wildlife, and other instream beneficial uses.
- Submit change petition to State Water Board with proof of consult and any comments received from RWQCB and/or CDFW.

Step Two – Petition Acceptance

- State Water Board notifies Petitioner if the petition is accepted or incomplete (typically within 30 days of submittal).

Step Three – State Water Board Analysis

- State Water Board examines the project’s potential environmental impacts and determines whether mitigation measures will be needed.
- State Water Board considers the effect of the project on public trust resources.
- State Water Board evaluates if the change could result in a decrease in stream flow and/or if hydrologic analysis is needed.
- State Water Board must find the change does not injure other legal users of water, including the environment, and that the petition is in the public interest.

Step Four – Notice of Petition and Protests

- State Water Board publishes notice of the petition and invites public comment/protests. There is a 30-day comment/protest period from the date of submittal.
- Petitioner and any protestant(s) shall make a good faith effort to resolve the protest(s) amicably within 180 days after the protest period ends.
- If any protest(s) cannot be resolved amicably, subject to State Water Board protest procedures (i.e., hearing for major projects or field investigation for minor projects).

Step Five – Resolution/Approval

- If protests are ultimately resolved, and if the State Water Board determines the proposed change meets the criteria set forth in Step Three above, an order is then issued granting the requested changes. Conditions may be imposed to ensure the criteria are satisfied.
- If any protests cannot be resolved or are ultimately decided against Petitioner, or if the State Water Board determines the criteria above cannot be satisfied, the petition may be denied.

Fees

The State Water Board fee is \$1,000 plus \$0.40 per each acre-foot greater than 10 acre-feet based on the total annual amount of diversion covered by the License, or \$20,000 whichever is less. An additional \$850 for CA Department of Fish and Wildlife is required. The total is approximately \$5,000 which is within the General Manager’s discretion to approve.

Summary of Proposed Change Petition

(For more comprehensive information, refer to the “Attachment to Petition for Change.”)

By this Petition for Change, the District seeks to:

- (1) Remove the acreage cap on the place of use within the District for irrigation purposes to authorize use anywhere within Petitioner’s service area.

RRFC’s license imposes a limitation on the place of use for irrigation purposes within the District of 4,096 acres within the place of use gross area of 16,505 acres. Removal of the place of use limitation will allow the District to serve the same amount of licensed water to more customers on more acreage to provide water security for the community and decrease reliance on groundwater. It will not, and cannot, result in any additional water use as the District is limited by its licensed amount.

- (2) Remove the acreage cap on the place of use within the Redwood Valley County Water District (RVCWD) for irrigation purposes to authorize use anywhere within the service area of RVCWD.

RRFC's license imposes a limitation on the place of use within the service area of RVCWD of 2,000 net acres within a gross area of 3,500 acres. As in the above point, removal of the place of use limitation will allow for more water security to the Redwood Valley community within the licensed amount of water available to RRFC.

- (3) Expand the licensed place of use to make the boundaries of the District's place of use coterminous with the boundaries of water suppliers to which the District supplies water and to meet existing agricultural demands;

Including the entire service areas of municipal water purveyors and the Hopland Rancheria, home to the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians, will provide a potential supply of stored water to municipal areas and Hopland Tribal lands, especially during water supply shortages and future changes in the trans basin diversion. There may be some minor edits to the proposed place of use changes prior to the application submission.

Expanding the place of use to include additional agricultural acreage that are currently served by the property owner's own water rights will provide an alternative water source during water supply shortages and future changes in the trans basin diversion.

A term is included in the change petition that any and all of the changes requested as described above will be conditioned that no Licensed water will be made available to land that has not historically been used for agricultural purposes. The District has requested this condition because it is asking to add additional places of use to apply water for agricultural purposes. If this condition is not included, the District would have to analyze the environmental effects of creating new irrigated land. Therefore, the District is promising that no licensed water will be delivered to land that hasn't been historically irrigated.

- (4) Remove the condition that only surplus water be supplied to RVCWD on satisfaction of the condition that RVCWD be annexed into the District.

The District is preparing an annexation application to expand its boundaries to include the entire RVCWD service area, therefore the limitation of providing only surplus water will no longer be relevant. The annexation is expected to be complete after the change petition application submittal but prior to the approval of the change petition.

- (5) Add additional points of rediversion, abandon existing licensed points of rediversion, and update existing licensed points of rediversion.

The District proposes adding points of rediversion to allow water sale contracts to more customers during water supply shortages and future changes in the trans basin diversion, resulting in greater security and flexibility for water users. Specifically, the District is seeking to add all relevant points of diversion for rights and claims of right on file with the State Water Board within the boundaries of the District as licensed points of rediversion.

The number of points of diversion has increased from the current 86 to 149. The District is moving away from labeling these points under the current contract name to using the US Army Corps of Engineers river miles. There may be some minor edits to the proposed points prior to the application submission.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

The District’s legal counsel has advised that it is common practice to submit change documents to the State Water board without having completed CEQA. CEQA must be completed before a project is approved and submittal of the petition does not equal approval. The District will need to complete CEQA before the Board approves the petition. Staff and Legal Counsel will complete the required CEQA as soon after the change petition submission as possible.

Recommendation:

- Move to approve Resolution #25-05 approving Petition for Change Application Package for Submittal to State Water Resources Control Board;
and
- Direct General Manager and Legal Counsel to submit the complete petition to change application package to the State Water Board with the required fees, allowing for minor edits to the points of diversion and place of use by GM Salomone and Legal Counsel.

Approving Petition for Change Application Package for Submittal to State Water Resources Control Board

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Russian River Flood Control & Water Conservation Improvement District ("**District**") is an improvement district organized and operating pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 54 of the Water Agency Acts entitled the Mendocino County Water Agency Act ("**Act**"). Pursuant to Sections 101 and 102 of the Act, the District has all the rights, duties, powers, liabilities, purposes, privileges, and immunities conferred and specified by the Act on the Mendocino County Water Agency. Chapter 54 §3(s) of the Act provides that the District, as an improvement district within the Mendocino County Water Agency, has the power "to divert, produce, store, transmit, distribute, and sell or otherwise furnish surface waters and ground waters or beneficial uses within or without the Agency"; and

WHEREAS, the District has been granted the right to divert east fork Russian River Water, redivert water released from storage in Lake Mendocino, and withdraw water from storage in Lake Mendocino in a total amount not to exceed 7,940 acre feet per year pursuant to License 13898 ("**License**") issued by the California State Water Resources Control Board ("**State Board**"); and

WHEREAS, in response to requests from landowners and water suppliers within the boundaries of the District to divert water under the District's License at additional points of diversion not included in the License, on additional historically irrigable acreage, and in an expanded place of use, the District has prepared a Petition for Change ("**Petition**") that requests the following changes to the District's License:

- (1) Remove the acreage cap on the place of use within the District for irrigation purposes to authorize use anywhere within Petitioner's service area;
- (2) Remove the acreage cap on the place of use within the Redwood Valley County Water District ("**RVCWD**") for irrigation purposes to authorize use anywhere within the service area of RVCWD;
- (3) Expand the licensed place of use to make the boundaries of the District's place of use coterminous with the boundaries of water suppliers to which the District supplies water and to meet existing agricultural demands;

- (4) Remove the condition that only surplus water be supplied to RVCWD on satisfaction of the condition that RVCWD be annexed into the District; and
- (5) Add additional points of rediversion, abandon existing licensed points of rediversion, and update existing licensed points of rediversion.

WHEREAS, the full Petition consists of the following documents:

- (1) Petition for Change Form
 - (2) Attachment to Petition for Change Form
 - (3) Maps accompanying Petition for Change Form
 - (4) Environmental Information Form
- (collectively, “**Petition Package**”)

WHEREAS, the District Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to submit the Petition Package to the State Board to (1) eliminate restrictions on the District’s License that allow for more water users to benefit from the District’s access to stored water in Lake Mendocino when other water rights and sources are unavailable and (2) assist in compliance with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act by allowing the broadest use of water under the License; and

WHEREAS, the submission and ultimate approval of the Petition Package will result in no expansion of water use under the District’s License as the District will continue to deliver the same amount of water (as limited by its License) but to additional points of rediversion, for use on additional historically irrigable acreage, and in an expanded place of use; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees heard and fully considered all oral and written public comment and General Manager’s report on the Petition at a Regular Board Meeting on July 7, 2025, to solicit public comments on the Petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Board of Trustees hereby approves the following:

1. The facts set forth in the recitals above and in the documents referenced therein are true and correct, and the Board so finds and determines.
2. The Petition Package is hereby approved for submission to the State Board.

INTRODUCTION

Petitioner's license on Permit 12947B (License 13898) was issued on September 21, 2017 ("**License**"). The License does not allow Petitioner to use water within Petitioner's entire service area and does not include all points of diversion currently utilized by Petitioner's customers to divert water under their own rights. In addition, the License imposes restrictions on acreage to be irrigated within Petitioner's boundaries, as well as limitations on acreage within Redwood Valley County Water District ("**RVCWD**"). Finally, the License imposes restrictions upon water delivery to RVCWD that will need to be eliminated if RVCWD is annexed into Petitioner's boundaries.

The changes being requested by Petitioner through this Petition are needed in order to assist Petitioner in complying with the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act ("**SGMA**") by allowing the broadest use of water under the License. Petitioner intends to utilize conjunctive use to maximize surface water use within its boundaries, in combination with other surface water rights held by its customers.

PETITIONER'S LICENSE

In 1949, the California Department of Finance filed applications 12919 and 12920 to appropriate water from the Russian River in furtherance of the Coyote Valley Project ("**Applications**"). In 1955, the Applications were partially assigned by the state to Sonoma County Flood Control and Water Conservation District as Applications 12919A and 12920A ("**Assigned Applications**") conditioned on partial reassignment to Petitioner, which was completed in 1956.

In 1961, the State Board issued Decision 1030 ("**Decision 1030**") which approved the Assigned Applications held jointly by the Sonoma District and Petitioner and ordered issuance of Permits 12947 and 12948. A copy of Petitioner's original 1961 permit (as supplied by SWRCB staff) is submitted with this Petition for Change. In 1974, by Order WR 74-30, the State Board revoked Permit 12948, consolidated all permitted uses into Permit 12947, and separated the entitlements of Sonoma (12947A) and Petitioner (12947B).

In 1979, the State Board approved a change in place of use for Permit 12947B to include nearby RVCWD on the condition that the additional place of use only receive water supplies surplus to the needs of Petitioner.

Petitioner's License authorizes diversion to storage at Lake Mendocino as well as direct diversion at 86 listed points of diversion and rediversion on the East Fork of the Russian River.

The License authorizes domestic, municipal and industrial uses anywhere within Petitioner's service area and recreational use at Lake Mendocino. However, Petitioner's License imposes a limitation on the place of use for irrigation purposes within the District of 4,096 acres net within a gross area of 16,505 acres. The License imposes a further limitation on the place of use for irrigation purposes within the RVCWD of 2,000 acres net within a gross area of 3,500 acres.

The service area boundaries of the District include 51,000 acres, with a larger 312,675-acre sphere of influence. By contract, the District provides raw water to agricultural irrigators and municipal water purveyors within its boundaries. When treatment is required, the municipal service provider treats and distributes the water to its customers. The District does not own or operate any facilities or infrastructure with the exception of meters; its customers are responsible for their own infrastructure and delivery systems. The District's License is its only actively used water supply.

As of June 2025, District contractors included 8 municipal customers and 52 individual agricultural, industrial, and domestic customers who contracted for a total of 7,940 acre-feet, the District's full annual supply under its License.

PETITION FOR CHANGE

By this Petition for Change, Petitioner seeks to:

- (1) Remove the acreage cap on the place of use within the District for irrigation purposes to authorize use anywhere within Petitioner's service area;
- (2) Remove the acreage cap on the place of use within the RVCWD for irrigation purposes to authorize use anywhere within the service area of RVCWD;
- (3) Expand the licensed place of use to make the boundaries of the District's place of use coterminous with the boundaries of water suppliers to which the District supplies water and to meet existing agricultural demands;
- (4) Remove the condition that only surplus water be supplied to RVCWD on satisfaction of the condition that RVCWD be annexed into the District; and
- (5) Add additional points of rediversion, abandon existing licensed points of rediversion, and update existing licensed points of rediversion.

PLACE OF USE

As stated above, this Petition for Change Petitioner seeks removal of the irrigable acreage cap, and an expansion of the licensed place of use to allow water for irrigation to be used anywhere within the service area of the District and the RVCWD. In addition, Petitioner seeks to add additional areas to its place of use to make the boundaries of the District's place of use coterminous with the boundaries of water suppliers to which the District supplies water.

Petitioner's License imposes a limitation on the place of use for irrigation purposes within the District of 4,096 acres net within a gross area of 16,505 acres. The License imposes a further limitation on the place of use for irrigation purposes within the RVCWD of 2,000 acres net within a gross area of 3,500 acres.

Justification for Removal of Irrigable Acreage Cap for Use Within District

Decision 1030, which ordered issuance of Petitioner's original permit, references and incorporates multiple exhibits, including a 1948 report by the Army Corps of Engineers titled "Survey Report for Flood Control and Allied Purposes on Russian River, California" ("USACE Report"). The USACE Report analyzed the effects of the Coyote Valley Project on water supply and development in the Russian River watershed. The Report estimated an increase in net irrigated acreage from the *initial stage* of the Project as compared to 1944 conditions of 4,096 acres in Mendocino County (USACE Report, Table 10), and an ultimate increase under full Project build-out of 8,858 net acres (USACE Report, Table 11). The Report estimated an increase in farm delivery demand as compared to 1944 conditions under the *initial stage* of the Project of 8,075 acre-feet per annum (USACE Report, p. 13).

Based on the USACE Report, the California Department of Finance conditioned the Assigned Applications on reassignment to Petitioner of "an amount of project water reasonably required for beneficial use on not to exceed 4,096 acres..." (Decision 1030, p. 14). Subsequently, Decision 1030 ordered issuance of permits on the Assigned Applications for the "net increase" of irrigated lands that could be served from the initial stage of the Coyote Valley Project, or, 7,940 acre-feet to irrigate the 4,096 additional acres.

Interestingly, the original permit issued to Petitioner in 1961 did not contain the irrigable acreage limitation described in Decision 1030. Without explanation, this limitation was nevertheless included in Petitioner's issued License. As a result, Petitioner's License severely limits the place of use for irrigation purposes despite capacity to serve significant additional acreage with the same amount of licensed water, for the reasons illustrated below:

- The water duty per acre has changed dramatically since 1944 based on improvements to application of irrigation water (e.g., flood irrigation and sprinklers have transitioned to drip irrigation and micro sprinklers).
- The District has seen changes in crop types to those with much lower consumptive use (e.g., hops and fruit trees have transitioned to vineyards). As shown in the USACE Report, farm delivery amounts per acre in 1948 were assumed to be significantly higher than what is being used today on any crop in Mendocino County (the Corps assumed 1.5 af/acre for Class 1 land, 2.5 af/acre for Class 2 land, and 3.5 af/acre for Class 3A land). More current estimates range from 0.5 af/acre to 2.5 af/acre (UC Cooperative Extension (2008) "Irrigated Agriculture Water Needs and Management in the Mendocino County Portion of the Russian River Watershed", p. 23).
- The water used under the District's License is not the sole water source for every irrigable acre within the District's service area. District customers often exercise their individual water rights within the District's irrigation place of use and utilize water from District contracts to supplement supply around the terms of their own water right, such as amount, timing, or flow. Therefore, District water for irrigation may be used only on the additional

acreage for a short period of time during the water year while other individual water rights are being exercised for the remainder.

- While the imposition of an acreage limitation for irrigation purposes may have been prudent in 1961 when the District's initial Permit was issued, the District now has a water right that cannot serve the population it was intended to serve despite available water under its License and landowner demand. Offering additional surface water supplies to landowners anywhere within the District's service area will provide the flexibility needed to address dynamic changes in climate and water supply uniquely affecting this area (e.g., reduced supply for individual water rights caused by drought and operational changes by PG&E related to the Potter Valley Hydroelectric Project) and to comply with SGMA.

Removal of the place of use limitation for irrigation purposes from the District's License will not, and cannot, result in any additional water use as the District is limited by its licensed amount, which was recently confirmed and established. In contrast, removal of the place of use limitation will allow the District to serve the same amount of licensed water to more customers on more acreage to provide water security for the community and decrease reliance on groundwater.

As explained below, to ensure removal of the irrigable acreage cap will not result in conversion of any native lands to irrigated agriculture, the District requests that any approval of this request be conditioned that no Licensed water will be made available to land that has not historically been used for agricultural purposes.

Justification for Removal of Irrigable Acreage Cap for Use Within RVCWD

Background on RVCWD

RVCWD provides domestic and agricultural water services to the community of Redwood Valley. RVCWD's water supply consists of a permit (Permit 17593) to appropriate up to 4,900 afa from the East Fork Russian River at Lake Mendocino. By direct diversion, RVCWD is authorized to appropriate water (1) at the maximum rate of 26.6 cubic feet per second (cfs) from March 1 to April 30 of each year for frost protection purposes, and (2) at the maximum rate of 1.9 cfs from November 1 to April 30 of each year for domestic purposes. By diversion to storage, RVCWD is authorized to appropriate up to 2,800 afa from November 1 of each year to April 30 of the following year. The maximum rate of diversion to off stream storage under Permit 17593 is 26.6 cfs. RVCWD is authorized to provide irrigation water to a net area of up to 3,300 acres within a gross area of 5,000 acres.

Conditions 16 and 17 of Permit 17593 make the permit subject to (1) an agreement between RVCWD and Sonoma County Water Agency to limit diversions to periods when the water level in Lake Mendocino cannot be increased due to the requirement to preserve flood control capacity, and (2) an agreement between RVCWD and the Department of Fish and Game to limit diversions to periods when the surface level of water in Lake Mendocino is above the conservation pool. These limitations represent a relatively narrow window of opportunity for diversions that can be as much as 70 days in wet years or as little as one or two days in dry years. RVCWD has only

exercised this right once in the last 5 years for less than 8-acre feet. These limiting conditions result in the need for RVCWD to seek alternative water supplies, including purchase of surplus supplies from the District. RVCWD is currently under a court-ordered moratorium for domestic water connections and a self-imposed moratorium for irrigation connections due to the resulting water supply instability.

RVCWD provides domestic and agricultural water services to the community of Redwood Valley, including a total of 1,105 equivalent dwelling units and 197 agricultural customers. Redwood Valley's service area is roughly 15 square miles in area. In 2024 RVCWD delivered approximately 350 AFY for residential and commercial uses, and 390 AFY for agricultural purposes - a combined annual demand of 740 AFY. In 2024, RVCWD became a member of the Ukiah Valley Water Authority, a joint powers authority that empowers coordinated use of each member's respective water supplies and systems to maximize availability which is planned to increase RVCWD's domestic water supply and improve reliability.

As above, to ensure removal of the irrigable acreage cap will not result in conversion of any native lands to irrigated agriculture, the District requests that any approval of this request be conditioned that no Licensed water will be made available to land that has not historically been used for agricultural purposes.

RVCWD and the District

In 1979, the State Board approved the District's petition to change its place of use to add the service area of Redwood Valley County Water District. Initially, the District requested that irrigation water be available to 2,000 net acres within the RVCWD service area until additional systems could be constructed to deliver more water. Later, this acreage limitation for irrigation use within RVCWD was included in Petitioner's License.

Since 1979, considerable improvements have been made to RVCWD's conveyance infrastructure enabling application of irrigation water throughout its service area. The circumstances described above regarding reduced water duty per acre, planting of crops with a lower consumptive use, and desire for supplemental and duplicative water supplies apply equally to RVCWD's service area.

In addition, as above, removal of the place of use limitation for irrigation purposes within RVCWD's service area would not result in any additional water use as the District is limited by its recently confirmed licensed amount. Removal of the place of use limitation within RVCWD would allow the District to serve additional irrigable acreage without any expansion in use.

Justification for Additional Places of Use

Petitioner provides raw water for irrigation and wholesale water to municipal water purveyors within its boundaries and place of use.

The District's Sphere of Influence includes the entire service area of several municipal water purveyors which are currently not entirely within the District's licensed place of use. Therefore, by this petition the District seeks to expand the boundaries of the District's place of use to be

coterminous with the boundaries of municipal water purveyors to which the District supplies wholesale water. These municipal water purveyors include: City of Ukiah, Millview County Water District, Redwood Valley County Water District, and Willow County Water District.

The District also seeks to include additional areas within its place of use that are within the boundaries of the East Sanel Irrigation Company. This area, shown more particularly on the accompanying maps, consists of lands owned by existing District customers that are just outside the District's licensed place of use. Currently, these customers use their own water rights for lands outside the District place of use and those individual rights are under threat resulting from changes to the trans basin diversion and climate change. Therefore, these customers have expressed a desire for the District to expand its licensed place of use to include these additional lands.

In addition, the District seeks to expand its place of use to include additional existing irrigable acreage inadvertently left out of the original requested place of use. This additional acreage consists of portions of landowner ranches missed or improperly left out of the original requested place of use. The District now seeks to correct these inconsistencies by including entire ranches/APNs in its licensed place of use to allow customers to apply District water to their entire property, rather than just portions of it. This will allow customers to implement conjunctive use of surface and groundwater and provide more flexibility within the District.

Finally, the District seeks to add to its authorized place of use areas of the Hopland Rancheria, home to the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians. When possible, the District seeks to provide an option to supply stored water to Tribal lands as redundancy for domestic supply, especially during water supply shortages and future changes in the trans basin diversion. The Hopland Band has its own water rights to divert from the Russian River which water is wheeled through Hopland Public Utility District infrastructure. Therefore, the Tribe would be able to utilize existing infrastructure to deliver any purchased District water.

The total additional acreage the District seeks to add to its licensed place of use is 5,249 acres, as shown more particularly on the accompanying maps.

To reiterate, expansion of the licensed place of use will not, and cannot, result in any additional water use, as the District is limited by its licensed amount. In contrast, expansion will allow the District to serve the same amount of licensed water to more customers on more acreage to provide water security for the community.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following are requested terms and conditions to include in any approved amendment to the License:

1. Any and all of the changes requested as described above will be conditioned that no Licensed water will be made available to land that has not historically been used for agricultural purposes.

2. Remove Surplus Limitation. As noted in District’s License, Water Right Order 79-15 approved delivery of water to the RVCWD by the District “only until the same is necessary to supply water for any existing or future use of water within the [District]”. In other words, the District’s License includes a condition restricting delivery of only surplus water supplies to RVCWD. This condition was included as a compromise to protests received from landowners who expressed concern they would not be able to purchase additional supplies from the District in the future if RVCWD contracted for water.

The District and RVCWD are working cooperatively to annex RVCWD into the boundaries of the District through Mendocino County Local Agency Formation Commission proceedings. The goal of the annexation is to allow RVCWD to expand its authorized place of use under its existing Uniform Water Sale and Purchase Agreement with the District to provide a more stable water source, primarily for the agricultural customers and also as an emergency backup for domestic supply for the entirety of RVCWD’s service area. Upon annexation, Petitioner considers the supply of water to RVCWD as an in-District customer to be a “future use of water within the [District]” as contemplated by Order 79-15, negating the need for the limiting surplus condition.

As such, Petitioner requests that the condition in the License limiting supply to RVCWD of only surplus water be removed (the entirety of Sections 3b. and 4b. of the Place of Use) upon the express condition that a Certificate of Completion of the annexation is recorded with the Mendocino County Recorder’s Office following final annexation of RVCWD into the District.

POINTS OF DIVERSION AND REDIVERSION

There are currently 86 points of diversion and rediversion authorized under Petitioner’s License on the East Fork Russian River and main stem Russian River, between Lake Mendocino and the Mendocino/Sonoma County line.

Petitioner proposes adding 98 points of rediversion detailed below (and on the accompanying maps) to its License to allow Petitioner to offer water sale contracts to more customers resulting in greater flexibility for water users within the District. Specifically, the District is seeking to add all relevant points of diversion for rights and claims of right on file with eWRIMS within the boundaries of the District as licensed points of rediversion under the District’s License. These additional points of rediversion consist of already constructed diversion works currently utilized to divert under individual water rights and would not require any new construction.

The Petitioner also proposes abandoning 36 points of diversion and rediversion and update the location of 6 existing licensed points of diversion and rediversion.

While preparing maps of the additional points of rediversion to be added to the District’s License under this Petition, Petitioner attempted to utilize data from eWRIMS for existing points of diversion under individual’s water rights and discovered many mapping inconsistencies (e.g., eWRIMS shows the point of diversion nearby, but not at its actual location). Therefore, on the maps submitted with this Petition, Petitioner has identified the additional points of rediversion in their actual locations which may result in some minor discrepancies between their location under this License and under the individual’s water right.

An original map and one copy are required.

Size – No larger than 28x40, no smaller than 8 ½ x 11.

Type – Original shall be permanently rendered to a suitable scale on linen, mylar or equivalent material.

Preparer – CA registered/licensed civil engineer or land surveyor.

Requirements –

1. Map must show from which water is to be taken, all dams, main conduits, reservoirs and other facilities, the important streams and tributaries in the area, the place of use, and any other features necessary for ready identification and understanding of the project.
2. Map shall show lines of the public land survey by 40-acre subdivision, section and township if the area is sectionalized. If not, see section 715(b).
3. Map shall show points of original diversion and of rediversion from any natural stream either by: (1) bearing and distance or co-ordinate distances from some corner of a recorded survey if such corner exists within a distance of 2 miles; (2) bearing and distance or co-ordinate distances from some permanent monument or a natural object; or (3) co-ordinates and zone of the California Co-Ordinate System.
4. Map shall identify place of use by reference to 40-acre subdivision, section, township, range and meridian of the public land survey or projection thereof, or by reference to the smallest subdivision of some other recorded survey if more commonly used within the project area except as otherwise provided in Section 719. If described by reference to some other recorded survey, the lines of the public land survey, or projection thereof, should be shown. The 40-acre subdivisions of the public land survey will be assumed regular unless it be shown otherwise.
5. Map shall be titled, show the meridian and scale and bear the California certificate and registration number of the engineer or surveyor. Example included in Section 717(c).
6. Contour maps of surface reservoirs shall be submitted with contour intervals not greater than those specified in Section 717(d). For dams less than five feet high, the high water contour shall be shown and the elevation of the maximum and minimum water surfaces shall be stated.

7. All contour maps shall show the high water line and state the elevation thereof, and include an area-capacity curve or table.
8. Maps accompanying applications for municipal purposes shall show the location of the place of use by outer boundaries. Sections and townships of the public land survey or projections shall be superimposed upon the map.
9. Where irrigation is proposed by a public district organized under statute, a public utility, or a mutual water company, the exterior boundaries of the general service area may be shown in lieu of compliance with the provisions of Section 715(d). Where irrigation of very large areas is proposed, the board may, in its discretion, waive compliance with the provisions of Section 715(d) and accept as sufficient an identification of the exterior boundaries of the general area to be irrigated.
 - a. Section 715(d) is enumerated as "4." In this document.
10. Map shall depict any changes in property ownership(s) involved, and the point(s) of diversion and place(s) of use of other known users of water who may be affected by the proposed changes.
