DETAILS

Del Norte County, Humboldt County, Trinity County



Impacts:

- Travel could be difficult to impossible across mountain passes
- Increased chance of chain restrictions
- Localized tree damage possible in areas of heavy snow

Timing:

Round 1: Tonight and Tuesday

Round 2: Tuesday night and Wednesday

Round 3: Friday night and Saturday

- Round 1: Snow levels 5,000 feet falling to 2,500 feet by the afternoon.
- Round 2: Snow levels of 2,000 to 3,500 feet throughout the day, lowest in Trinity County.
- Round 3: Possibly heavy snow as low as 2,000 to 3,000 feet in Trinity, Humboldt and Del Norte Counties



Del Norte County, Trinity County, Humboldt County, Mendocino County, Lake County



Impacts:

- Increased risk of tree damage and debris on roadways
- Increased risk of localized power outages
- Unsecured objects may be blown away

Timing

- Round 1: Monday night and Tuesday morning Mainly in Del Norte and northern Humboldt
- Round 2: Wednesday
- Round 3: Friday night and Saturday

Round 1: Gusts to 45 mph over the higher terrain areas of Del Norte and Northern Humboldt counties.

Round 2: Gusts to 25 to 45 mph across much of the higher terrain and exposed coastal areas.

Round 3: Strong winds possible, but still highly uncertain.

Humboldt County, Del Norte County

Small Hail

Impacts:

- Increased risk of unexpectedly icy roadways near the coast
- Small hail could damage sensitive objects left outside

Timing:

Round 1: Tuesday afternoon and evening - Mainly in Del Norte county

Round 2: Wednesday - Humboldt and Del Norte counties

Del Norte County, Humboldt County, Trinity County, Mendocino County, Lake County

Rain

Impacts:

- Increased risk of rock and mudslides on roadways
- Increased flow in small streams
- Minor ponding and flooding during periods of moderate rain

Timing:


- Round 1: Tuesday and Wednesday
